

Simple Steps To Prevent A Dryer Vent Fire From Happening In Your Home:

- Do not use the dryer without a functional lint filter. Make sure you clean the filter before or after each use. Remove any lint that has collected around the drum.
- Verify that the exhaust vent pipe is not restricted and that the outside air flap opens while the dryer is operating.
- Routinely keep the dryer maintained to ensure safety and good working order. Have gas dryers inspected by a qualified professional to ensure the gas line and connections are free of leaks. Dryer vent specialists will remove any lint that may have built up along the exhaust vent.
- Be certain that the correct plug and outlet are used and that the hookups are connected properly.
- Always follow the manufacturers operating instructions.
- Turn off the dryer before you leave the home or go to bed.

Hidden Dangers of a Blocked Vent:

- Failure to clean the dryer or connecting vent has always been the #I reason for a fire.
- Reports state that the first items to ignite are lint, fiber, and dust.
- Unmaintained dryers can also cause electrical fires and leak Carbon Monoxide. Vents can be clogged by birds nests or improper vent pipe.
- Residual water that is expelled from the clothes when being dried can not evaporate when the vent is clogged. The results are; mold, bad odor and health risks.
- Home fires involving clothes dryers from 1980-2010 have gone down from 24,100 a year to 16,800.
